> I have a loop that has, among other things, the following commands:
>
> openw,1,command_file
> .
> close,1
>
> This loop will run for quite a large number of iterations and then will give me
> the following error message:
>
> % OPENW: Error opening file: /sdss3/usrdevel/philf/bin/commands.txt.
> Too many open files
>
> I have tried using free_lun but it doesn't seem to help.

This sounds like a bug, and I seem to remember something like this in an earlier version of IDL. Which version are you using?

> Any suggestions?

Well, hard-coding the logical unit number in a program like you are doing is...how should I put it...suspect programming practice at best. :-)

Does something like this work any better?
