You are not alone. RSI themselves couldn't figure it out when they wrote the ASCII_TEMPLATE program. There they added a text widget that you type into, and *that* edits the table widget. Easier to edit the table widget in this roundabout, non-intuitive way than to memorize the particular magical incantations normally required, I guess.

But--in any case--I'm sure I've mentioned that I LOVE IDL at least a couple of times in the past week. And I do. I'm just not overly fond of the table widget. :-)
