I think the question is how does one prepare an array to receive a JPEG image read through the routine READ_JPEG. The answer is that you don't have to--the READ_JPEG routine will take care of this for you. Just use something like

```
READ_JPEG, "myfile.jpg", MYIMAGE
```

and the array MYIMAGE will be created automatically for you, and will contain the image.

A pentium computer with 128 megabytes of RAM sounds like a very good system to me.
