I don't know how this would translate in to ENVI, since I haven't used that program, but in IDL, I did as follows. After each pass through the loop that creates the animation on screen, I did a tvrd to get a copy of the graphics screen, and then wrote the result to a GIF file with a sequential number for a file name. Then, I could use a third party program (I don't remember now what it was, but could track it down) to compile the GIF sequence to an AVI. Hope this is somewhat helpful.
