I'm writing a couple of programs that are to be distributed with runtime licences. I would like to know whether it is possible to create a preferences file so that the user can have the program set up in the way that they want.

I know that I can easily create a defaults file, but what I want is for \*THEM\* to be able to \*edit\* it from the runtime. I know that the runtime distribution doesn't allow you to create .sav files so I don't really hold out much hope!.. any ideas?...
