> on the small window, choose "Table of IDL devices"
> once you have that help in the window, go to the top and click on
> "Keywords Accepted by the IDL Device"
> Choose ENCAPSULATED or (PS) next to ENCAPSULATED.

> On 2 of the computers (different installation) I have access, after this
> last choice, it just got me out of X-window and prompt me to the Login
> one.
