## Ken,

I can not see any difference in how you defined 'display\_1' and 'display\_2' in your sample code - they are totally identical. If you are saying that one does pass events and another does not, there must be a difference in your real code - possibly a typo which causes xmanager to direct events from 'display\_2' to a wrong destination.

I have no idea what did you use /JUST\_REGISTER for. I never used it and all my applications (quite complex multi-panel, multi-layered, multi-window, with obj graphics and read/write, etc.) work ok. Try getting rid of this keywords.

Try at the very end of laying out the widget trees doing:

widget\_control, display\_2\_id, event\_pro = 'manifold\_event'

If it helps, then you have a typo in the code above it. Cheers,
