I have the following message error on my program, when I destroy a draw widget and create another in the same base widget (it isn't a top level base). But this doesn't happen all the times, just when I switch between the widgets without drawing more than one time to each!

goes some output that I copied to this message:

IDL> .STEP

% Program caused arithmetic error: Floating illegal operand ;self.wdvel contains the ID of the draw widget:

IDL> help, self.wdvel

<Expression> LONG = 273

;The statement that caused the error was: widget_control, self.WDvel, /DESTROY;self.WDvel is a draw widget ID.
