I have just installed IDL on RedHat 5.2 and since there are some problems with colortables and fvwm2 (see earlier article in thsi newsgroup -- btw: lesstif works) I had asked RSInc about the patch mentioned earlier. They repied it's a pretty old piece of code and not certain that it would still apply. FUrthermore I learned, that the RedHat version currently supported by RSInc is 5.1 (not 5.2). I dropped a hint that 6.0 is available soon ... may take a while before they get into it though.
