> % Execution halted at: INSIGHT  
> % \$MAIN\$  
> On my portable machine I've Linux SuSe 6.0  
> How can I resolve this problem?

The 8-bit and 24-bit visuals are safe for IDL to use (PseudoColor and TrueColor).

should tell you the default visual, and what visuals are available.
