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Hi Mike,

Thanks for the explanation. The AND is the default when I get your web page. So any blank spaces ("fields") means that there will be no relevant FAQ's found. At first, I didn't understand what the Question and Answer referred to (forgetting what the Q in FAQ means) After your explanation and once I got used to it, it was ok. If someone is trying the FAQ for the first time, it may be better to have the default set to OR. (I actually didn't notice this choice when I tried last week).

Or maybe a "First Time User" button for a short explanation, similar to what you just wrote. (Although I had to think for a moment what you meant by "fields", I'm not too familiar with terminology) The search method is a little bit different from what I am used to with typical Web search engines (which have only one area to fill in keywords and are ineffective in many ways).

I hope this helps you. My personal FAQ consists of one directory where I save all interesting questions and answers from the newsgroup. Using 'grep' for keyword search is about as sophisticated as it gets.
