In the string put '!7x' this will give you a lower case omega. Upper case is capital x. this is explained in the reference guide volume 1 under the chapter on fonts. There are also a bunch of font tables also. Remember to reset the font by using !3 at the end of the string or in the next string. If you do not then all of your fonts will remain in Greek font 7.
