Hi,

First thank you jeremy for your help. it definitely helped. What was actually causing the problem was that /lib/ld-2.0.7.so existed (redhat upgrade left it there) but libc-2.1.1.so was also in the same directory. So it was using incompatible version of the libraries. So I just deleted ld-2.0.7 from the directory and now it is happily loading from the /usr/i386-glibc20-linux/lib directory.

As a side note before running the idl license manager you have to preload /usr/i486-linux-libc5/lib/ (or wherever you have the libc 5.0 libraries). When is idl and the license manager going to be updated. The license manager is archaic to run on libc 5.0 and wouldn't it be easy for idl to support more linux systems? I "think" it would be worth it.
