|> Hi folks,  
|> We just upgraded our Alpha with a 24-bit TurboChannel module. The problem  
|> is that in IDL color will only be displayed on tv (or any plot) if that  
|> window is highlighted, otherwise it is displayed in black and white. This  
|> doesn't occur when using IDL on our 8-bit X-terminals. Is there some  
|> keyword I'm missing? I tried a couple of things in the reference manual to  
|> no avail.

Try this. Start a "fresh" IDL session, and, as the first command, type in  
DEVICE,PSEUDO=8

Then try your plots. Worked for me on a Sun Sparc2 with 24-bit graphics.
