(-32 may be omitted on non Irix 6 systems) AHA!

Well, yesterday, when I was frantically searching around for a solution, I found that my new system is n32. I tried returning to o32 but did not know that the compiling AND ld commands had to have this -32 flag. This I saw on the FAQ.

Everything seems to work now, except some #84 warnings:
definition of main preempts that in /usr/lib/libftn.so
I hope they aren't serious.
