I haven't used ascii\_template that much. It returns a structure, which you than pass to read\_ascii via the 'template=' keyword, right? If you're reading files that have the same structure, you can just save the template to a save set (using save,variable,file=filename) which you restore when required. If you're talking about creating the template on demand, either you go through the Gui, or you prize apart how the structure works and fill the fields by hand. Then return to the previous step.
