If you mean the way that you can run idlwave-shell (formerly idl-shell) in an Emacs buffer with Unix-Emacs, I'm afraid not. Some time back, IDL for Windows *did* work as a command-line program, but alas, this has been lost with the advent of IDLDE. I have requested from RSI that this be reinstated if possible, but to no effect as yet.

Of course you can still use Emacs as your editor, then ask IDLDE to reload it after each save you do from Emacs. But it *sure* would be nice to have idlwave-shell...
