I recently spent quite a bit of time wondering why my automatic structure definition files could not be seen by IDL. All attempts to instantiate the structure in my calling program resulted in the error "attempt to call undefined procedure/function".

As it turns out, the problem was that I had a capital letter in my filename containing the structure definition procedure. Renaming it from `abc_Struct__define.pro` to `abc_struct__define.pro` remedied the problem, even though all references still contained the capital "S".

Has anybody else experienced this problem? Or perhaps it is not a problem at all, and I missed the explanation? This requirement is definitely not explained in the "Automatic Structure Definition" section.
