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I am making some simple xy scatterplots. I would like to make the y-axis label bigger (ie larger fontsize), but I don't want to change the size of the tick labels.

YCHARSIZE=xxx seems to change both in my experiments. Is that correct?

One possibility would be to add the axis label separately using XYOUTS or ANNOTATE, but in this case the text-box would have to be rotated to make it look like a y-axis label. For this reason it seems like a lot of work, though maybe it's not so bad as it seems?

Another possibility would be to add another axis with zero line weight but the correct size axis label? This seems like a kludge.
