Hi Kristine,

I am not familiar enough with CW_FORM to help in that respect. However, this is just an idea. I get the errors that you mention a lot when I define in the first line of a program a file:

PRO program_file

and then I try using EVENT_FUNC = program_file

IDL looks for a function when it is actually defined as a procedure. It usually drives me crazy because I see when I compile that the program is there and compiling, and still when the program is called, it can't find it.

Just checked CW_FORM and it expects a function. Is your event handler defined with PRO or FUNCTION?
