Structure fields can be indexed similarly to arrays. Use syntax similar to:

for i=0, n_elements(tag_names(My_struct))-1 do help, My_struct.(i), /struct

This will step through all sub-structures in My_struct. Notice that you MUST use parenthesis, not [] brackets, when indexing structures. Cheers, Pavel
