I didn't always have the BYTSCL there but put it in when I tried to use the split-colortable technique, (which did work when I looked at the same GIF file in two different windows) . Alas, it stayed there for the rest of my attempts. At home, on a PC, I got the wrong colors also but could at least see the plots, even with the BYTSCL.

So, Lessons learned Summary:

device, true=24, decomposed=0
window, /free, /pixmap
wdelete, !d.window

And do not BYTSCL the image with TV!
