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Greetings from the North, (man, it's been cold lately, hasn't it?)

I'm developing a Widget-based application, and in order not to use the whole 200+ color table values, I want to explicitly request only 8 colors for the window that is created when I do:

```
WIDGET_CONTROL, my_window_widget, /REALIZE
```

I know that this number-of-colors request is typically done using:

```
WINDOW, /FREE, COLORS=8 ; (before any other windows are brought up)
```

But to have to bring up and then destroy a window when bringing up my widget app is, shall we say, tacky. Any other suggestions?
