Hi,

Does anyone out there use idlwave mode for emacs/xemacs? I downloaded the .el files from Carsten Dominik's page at <http://strw.leidenuniv.nl/~dominik/Tools/idlwave/>, but I haven't been able to get it to work. Specifically, when I try to go to idlwave mode, I get the error "Symbol's function definition is void: eval-after-load", which I assume comes from the following piece of idlwave.el:

          fume-find-function-name-method-alist)))))

I've tried commenting this bit out, but get new problems instead.

So has anyone got this package to work? I am **not** an elisp expert, in case that wasn't immediately obvious.
