- > I'm seraching for a method to catch the close event that is produced,
- > when an IDL-Window is closed by the close button of the window frame, in
- > a non modal dialog.

Typically, I handle widget destroy events like this with a CLEANUP routine. I assign this to the top-level base by using the CLEANUP keyword to the XMANAGER command. By doing this, I don't care if my widget is killed by the QUIT button or by the user wielding a mouse. :-)
