Hi,

I'm sure the solution to this is trivial, but I can't seem to find it.

I'm plotting a single polar plot on a page. Afterward, I'd like to plot a series (P.MULTI style) of plots. I can get the first plot to go fine. However, no matter what I seem to do the second page of plots crashes with the error

Data coordinate system not established.

and all I get is a small bit of annotation in the upper right hand corner of an otherwise empty page. This occurs even when I try to plot only a single plot on the second page (e.g. !P.MULTI = 0).

Any suggestions as to what is happening and why? I've plotted multiple pages of plots, multiple window plots before, and never had a problem like this.
