Depends on what you are doing here. If you are trying to print it, you can do this:

```
Print, "Hello" + String(10b) + "There"
```

If you are putting it on a title of a plot, or writing it into a graphics window, you can do this:

```
XYOutS, 0.5, 0.5, Align=0.5, /Normal, "Hello!CThere"
```

> 2) When using Map\_Set I see lots of keywords for rotation, orientation,  
> etc but nothing to restrict the displayed lat lon. If what I want is a  
> lat-lon box (Not global) with continent overlays for example should I be  
> using something else? I'll gladly take and RTFM if someone can say  
> which FM?
