Oh, here. This is a program named WWindow. Call it like this:

```
WWindow, wtitle, XSize=400, YSize=400
Surface, Dist(40)
```

When you want to change the title of the window, type this:

```
Widget_Control, wtitle, TLB_Set_Title='Something Else'
```
