AB> to run idl 5.1.1. When I start up the idl-shell, I get the error
AB> message

AB> Process idl exited abnormally with code 1.

AB> The same configuration works on a different machine with idl
AB> 4.0.1. Anyone know what I should do to get the idl-shell to work?

Even though I have not seen this particular error message, the reason
might be:

idl.el and idl-shell.el are obsolete (they do not work reliably with
Emacs 20). Try the replacement modes idlwave.el and idlwave-shell.el.
