
Subject: Widget width in vertical base

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I just installed 5.2.1 (was using 5.1)
and I noticed that my horizontal sliders
in a vertical base no longer set their
width to the width of the base.

According to the documentation:

Horizontal Size of Widgets:

If any of the `BASE_ALIGN_*` keywords to `WIDGET_BASE` is set, each widget has its "natural" width, determined either by the value of the widget or by the `XSIZE` keyword. Similarly, if any of the child widgets specifies one of the `ALIGN_*` keywords, that widget will have its "natural" width. If none of the `BASE_ALIGN_*` or (`ALIGN_*`) keywords are set, all widgets in the base are as wide as their column.

I removed all `"*align"` keywords, but this did not solve the problem. The sliders remain their mundane size (100 pixels I think).

Anyone else notice this problem or know a solution?

I'm running IDL under HP-UX 10.20
