
Subject: Is it possible to make multiple SURFACE plots per page?

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I am running IDL under X on an RS6000. I have tried using the !p.multi system variable to make multiple plots with SURFACE on a single page, but the plots all end up superimposed upon one another in the lower left hand corner of the window. The first plot looks like it is drawn in the correct sized portion of the window (although not the upper left corner, as the manual would suggest), but successive plots are superimposed, rather than being drawn in successive 'panes' of the window.

!p.multi(0) counts down correctly as each plot is drawn. So:

- a) Is it not possible to do this?
- b) Is there something else I need to set?
- c) Is there some other way to do it?
- d) None of the above.
