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When using colortables (the built-in ones) with a plot, sometimes the axis color causes the axis and labels to disappear. I figure that it is because the axis and the labels are set to a particular element of the color table and that element is the same color as the background color of the plot window. How would I go about changing this without editing the color table? If I have to edit the color table, which element is the one that the axis and labels use, or how can I find out? I have this problem on the color table named either "prism" or "spectrum" (sorry, don't remember the number offhand).
