As far as I know, there isn't a way to create different linestyles like one can create different plot symbols. However, if you set PSYM to be less than zero, you'll get the symbol plus a line. So, to get a line with crosses at the data points, use Plot,x,y,PSYM=-1,LINESTYLE=0
