I've been using these two keywords for a long time to control the current visible range of plotted points on graphs. When the limits for the subplot are changed, the min/max values must be changed accordingly for the sliders.

BTW, I've used the Floating Point Slider and find it very cludgy and awkward (only updates upon an upclick). Would be nice to have RSI \*write their own\* in ANSI C and bring it up to the standards of the other widgets. Last I checked, the FP Slider is just a combination of a slider and a text widget.
