I played around with your colour-object for a while. One thing that strikes me is that you always have to know the decomposed-state to use it correctly.

Would it not be nice to add one more keyword like /penColor that would work always:

y = c->GetColor('yellow', /penColor)

returns GetColor('yellow', /indexNumber) in decomposed=0 state returns GetColor('yellow', /TrueColor) in decomposed=1 state

Then this would always work:

c=obj_new('DrawColors')
plot, findgen(11), \$
 color=c->GetColor('yellow', /penColor), \$
 background=c->GetColor('charcoal', /penColor)
obj_destroy, c

And I would not have to keep track of anything:)
