You are running the keyword check twice, which might slow you down if you have a lot of objects to create (I've played with making crystal structures containing tens of thousands of atom-objects), it will also run checks on any properties that you don't want (or need) to set at startup time.

If only to avoid spaghetti-ising the code, I would prefer to have seperate copies of the simple assignments in your example. If setting a property takes more than a up few lines I put it in its own private method that is called from both Init and SetProperty. This probably has more to do with the way my mind works than any real-world efficiency.
