Hi,

I have a small Fortran program (1000 lines) that I would like to translate to IDL. I've looked around the net for a translation utility, but can't find one. Does anyone know if there is such a thing? I'm now looking at making a simple utility like this myself. My aim is to make an IDL routine that can translate Fortran code line-by-line. I expect to translate about 80-90% of the code this way, leaving the rest for manual translation. Finally, the code must be restructured some (manually) to take advantage of IDL functions (Array manipulation, objects, etc.) Any Ideas?
