- > resize event when it is resized. After releasing the mouse button when I
- > resize the top base that contains my draw window, I get dozens of
- > events corresponding
- > to each intermediate size of the base as it is being dragged to its new
- > size. When the objects in the view are complex, resizing the window can
- > cause a noticeable delay.

- > Does anyone know how to avoid this? I'm using NT 4.0 -maybe this has
- > something to do with the problem?

Right click on your desktop. Choose the "Properties" menu. Find the Plus tab on the program that pops up. Turn OFF the check mark that says "Show Window Contents While Dragging."
