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It seems odd to me that I can't treat object arrays with the same elegance that is possible with all other array types. If I have a large list of objects of the same type, and I want to call the same method on each of them, do I really have to use a for loop? Wouldn't it be more consistent with the IDL philosophy to write: `object_array->method()` instead of: `for i=0,10 do object_array[i]->method()`

I'm just getting back into IDL after a short hiatus, and back to object programming in particular.. is there something I've missed?
