The most straightforward way, I think, is to convert your polar coordinates to XY coordinates and grid, if necessary, before contouring.

If you mean you would like your contour plot in a circular type plot, then I have had some luck converting coordinates to latitude/longitude coordinates and drawing the contours on a circular map projection.
