Question concerning DLL access/builds on a PPC Mac.

I have a large C library (normal static) with functions I wish to access in IDL. I wrote a set of wrappers to access the static lib in the IDL manner. I then compile the wrapper as a DLL and include the static lib in the link list. IDL refuses to find the symbol names via a call\_external.

This link a dll to a static lib strategy works on unix boxes.

Do I need to recompile the static library to a DLL for IDL access on a Mac?
