> *ZLIB compression for reading and writing gzipped files throughout, including
> SAVE's.

> It seems for those Linux users that older versions are no longer supported --
> RedHat 6.0 is baselined as the minimum OS (which basically means glibc>2.1 for
> those non-RH Linux users out there). I confirmed this with a segfault on my
> RH5.2 (glibc 2.0.7) machine. Time to upgrade.
