- > figures I do. Are there any scalable image formats?

We're pretty fond of making big windows, capturing them to JPEGs, then using jpeg2ps to convert them to EPS files. Level 2 postscript actually supports JPEG, so the EPS files are only about 10k larger than the original JPEG, with just a bit of wrapper around them. The result can be included in TeX or PDF documents.
