> I am making some surfaces using the SURFACE  
> command and the X axis label is vertical, as if  
> it were the Z axis label, instead of running  
> parallel to the axis. The Y axis label is OK,  
> but it is too close to the axis.  
>  
> Has anyone encountered this before?

Ah, yes. Hardware fonts don't rotate in 3D space  
for some inexplicable reason, even in PostScript  
output. You will have to use either software  
fonts (!P.Font=-1) or True-Type fonts (!P.Font=1).
