I am using this function and I was told by someone of RSI:

ROUTINE_NAMES is an undocumented command. It is highly recommended that you not use it in any code which you plan to run in future versions of IDL. Its argument and keyword lists may change, or it may disappear completely.

Use it at your own risk only in code which you won't mind changing again in the future.
