Just this morning I noticed another difference between IDL and WAVE -- WAVE is supposed to support CGM output whereas IDL does not claim to. Unfortunately, it turns out that the WAVE CGM does not conform to the standard. This is a problem for me, as the software that drives our film recorder supports CGM, but chokes on the files from WAVE. The film recorder does not support any of the other formats written by IDL or WAVE. I was hoping RSI would have solved the non-standard CGM problem, but CGM is not listed in the supported "devices." Has anyone come up against this problem, or have any suggestions for me?
