hello,

I am trying to find out if anyone has succesfully been able to create a margin at the top of a page while !p.multi is being used.

My scenario is that I have multiple plots on the page, and I want to xyout a title to the top of the page. No problem, but each plots has titles etc and I cannot figure out how to get !p.multi to leave x number of pixels margin on the top of the page.

As for using !p.region, it seems that this overwrite !p.multi (or has higher priority) and kills my !p.multi alltogether. !p.position seems to do nothing at all when combined with !p.multi. And !y.margin effects each of the plots, not the entire window (device)

any help would be appreciated.
