We had problems with unresolved sunview and numerical recipe (as I found out)
symbols in pwave.sparc.a.

I want to thank everybody who took the time to respond with suggestions
and clarifications for what exactly the undefined symbols were. As a
database person, and being pwave and plot illiterate, it was educational.

As it turns out, the problem had nothing to do with Sybase at all.
pwave.sparc.a is used by pwave itself and is not linked by calling
applications. Calling applications only need to link in rpc.sparc.a.
Once we removed pwave.sparc.a, everything worked like a charm and
the resulting combination of database and plot capabilities is pretty
impressive.
