- > (without /NO_BLOCK) but xmanager immediately returns.
- > Is there a common mistake I might have made?

No mistake. I'm guessing you are calling this program from within a widget program that is **itself** blocking. Only the first program that calls for a block actually blocks. All the rest run through the block. In practice you usually make these other program modal programs.
