Hi,

A question for those out there who have used call_external in IDL with (hopefully) C subroutines on the Macintosh.

I have an older version of Metrowerks Codewarrior (IDE 1.6.3, CW 9), and have set the Project type to shared library, in the preferences for the project. However, it doesn't seem to want to compile and produce the shared library (it keeps looking for main(), while the C file I'm compiling only contains a collection of subroutines).

I've (obviously) never created shared libraries before, so if anyone has any pointers to help create one of these things, that would be great. The documentation is scarce or non-existent in this matter.
